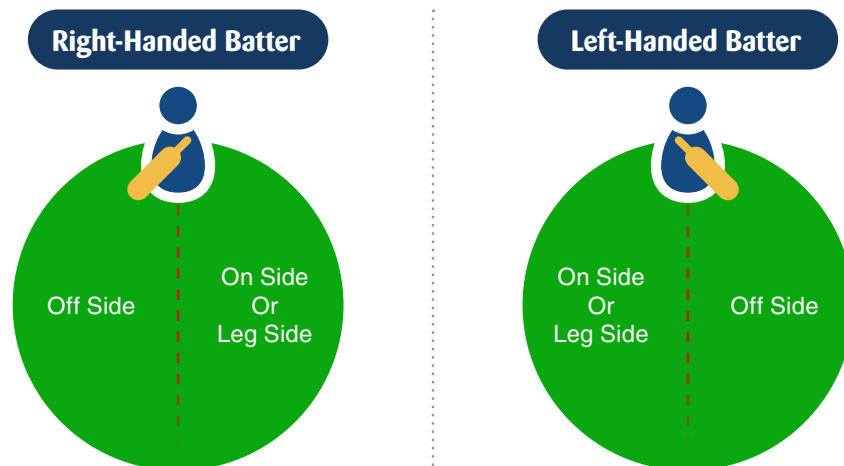


# Things to Remember When Fielding



- 1 I can use the fielding positions picture to learn the names of the different fielding positions

---

- 2 If I am still unsure, my Coach or Team Captain may be able to help show me where to stand in the field

---

- 3 The off-side and on-side of the field depends on whether the batter is right or left handed

---

- 4 The on-side, can also be called the leg side, it means the same thing.

---

- 5 If the batters switch over and one batter is right handed and the other is left handed, I might have to move to a different position in the field.

---

- 6 Sometimes, I might be asked to move further away from the batter and closer to the boundary; this is called being 'deep' or 'long'.

---

- 7 Sometimes, I may be asked to move closer to the batter; this is called being 'short'.  
For Example: When fielding a the position of point, I could be closer to the batter and this would be called 'short' point' or if I was closed to the boundary, it would be called deep point.
