



Developed by the Autism Association, the Social Magic program is a social skills curriculum focused on self-awareness, understanding others, communication, and friendships.

The curriculum consists of 5 therapy programs tailored to the specific support needs and goal areas of participants. These 5 magical topics are Making Magic, Social Sorcerers, Mystical Bites, Fantastical Feasts, and Myths and Magic. Each group runs over 8 weeks from 3.30pm to 5.30pm and is offered from different locations across the Perth metro area.



Making Magic

Develop early social skills such as taking turns, sharing, and initiating conversations with others. Suitable for children in school years 2-6 who may require a higher level of support to engage in a group setting.



Social Sorcerers

Develop advanced social skills including reading body language, understanding emotions in ourselves and others, and emotional regulation. Suitable for children in school years 2-6 who require low to moderate support to engage in discussion-based group activities.



Mystical Bites

Learn how to make snacks and develop awareness of safety and hygiene in the kitchen. Suitable for children in school years 7-12 who may require a higher level of support to engage in a group setting.



Fantastical Feasts

Use teamwork to cook some fantastical meals and develop independence skills in the kitchen. Suitable for children in school years 7-12 who require low to moderate support to engage in group discussions and activities.



Myths and Magic

Learn skills and strategies to prepare for the transition from primary school to high school. Suitable for children in year 6 who are preparing to transition to high school.

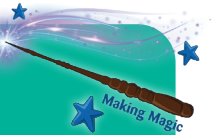
